The Bethesda Arts & Entertainment District's mission is to create and implement arts and entertainment projects that contribute to the artistic, cultural and economic growth of downtown Bethesda. The Board of Directors of the 501(c)3, non-profit organization fundraises and builds awareness to complete new arts and entertainment projects in downtown Bethesda.

The state of Maryland re-designated downtown Bethesda as an Arts & Entertainment District in 2012, after serving as a state A&E District for 10 years. Special tax incentives are in place that benefit artists, arts enterprises and developers that are located within the District. The Bethesda Urban Partnership manages the Bethesda Arts & Entertainment District, and the state of Maryland honored Bethesda with the "Award for Outstanding Achievement" in 2012.

Benefits

- Artists who live in Maryland and work in the Arts & Entertainment District can receive certain income tax breaks.
- * Developers who renovate or construct new spaces for arts' use can be exempt from paying certain property taxes on the value of the renovations for up to 10 years.
- Arts enterprises that charge the Admissions and Amusements tax are exempt from this tax.

The Bernard Ebb Songwring Awards provides local aspiring songwriters and bands the chance to win \$10,000 and perform in front of a live audience.

The **Bethesda Film Fest** features the work of local and regional documentary filmmakers.

The **Bethesda Fine Arts Festival** is a two-day event held the second weekend in May featuring 140 artists along with live entertainment.

The **Bethesda Literary Festival** takes place in April and celebrates the literary arts with 30 author events, writing contests, children's events and more.

Bethesda Outdoor Movies features five nights of blockbuster hits at the corner of Norfolk and Auburn Avenues during the third week of July.

The **Bethesda Painting Awards** is a juried competition and exhibition that awards \$14,000 in prize monies to selected painters, including \$10,000 for Best in Show.

Gallery B is the non-profit art gallery managed by the Bethesda Arts & Entertainment District that is available for local artists to rent and showcase their work.

Imagination Bethesda, held the first Saturday in June, is a street festival that celebrates children and the arts.

"Paint the Town" Mural Project is an initiative to promote more public art murals in downtown Bethesda.

Play In A Day challenges playwrights, directors and actors from D.C. area theatres to create original one-act plays in just 24 hours.

Studio B is an artist workspace featuring three individual artist studios and their original artwork.

The **Summer Concert Series** is held in Veterans Park on Thursday evenings from May through July.

Taste of Bethesda, held the first Saturday in October, is a renowned food and music festival that includes more than 50 restaurants and five stages of entertainment.

The Trawick Prize: Bethesda
Contemporary Art Awards is the annual
juried art competition honoring regional
artists across all media. \$14,000 in prize
monies is awarded, including \$10,000 for
Best in Show.

"Tunnel Vision: Art Under the Avenue" is a public art exhibit in the Metro pedestrian tunnel featuring the work of 12 regional artists.

Winter Wonderland, held the first weekend in December, features a professional choral concert, entertainment by local school groups and a visit from Santa Claus.
